Every patient has the right to make a complaint about the treatment or care they have received at Clement Road Medical Practice. Who to talk to?

Most complaints can be resolved at a local level. Please speak to a member of staff if you have a concern and they will assist you where possible. Alternatively, ask to speak to the Complaints Manager, (Practice Manager- Kal Dhaliwal) but note this may need to be a booked appointment.

If for any reason you do not want to speak to a member of our staff, then you can request that the Integrated Care Board (ICB) investigate your complaint. Access the services

At Clement Road GP Surgery, we offer appointments through a simple process called clinical triage. All you have to do is fill out a form online about your medical issue and it will be sent directly to our doctors. No login is required.

If you are a patient with visual impairment or an elderly patient and don't have internet access or a mobile device, don't worry. You can simply call us during our morning opening hours and our call centre will help you fill out the form over the phone.

After the doctor evaluates your form, they will respond to you via text message if you have internet access. They will then offer you advice, ask you to complete tests, suggest an appointment for an examination, or schedule a telephone call appointment. Rest assured that our doctors will provide the necessary care and support for your medical needs.

Medical records access

The Freedom of Information Act gives you the right to request information held by a public sector organisation. If you require access to your medical information. Please visit the surgery to fill in a form, it can take up to 30 days. Your online medical records will then be enabled and you can access it by the "NHS app" or "Patient Access".

Non-NHS medical services
